

## Press Release 30 March 2015

As already announced in the "Press Releases" and "News" on the website [www.ecolibri.it](http://www.ecolibri.it), in date 20 March 2015, the micro-wind turbine Ecolibri, installed recently in the Republic of Moldova in Chisinau via Grenoble, was officially inaugurated on the occasion of the international exhibition MOLDENERGY.

The ribbon cutting ceremony performed by Donatella Scarpa, Managing Director of ACE srl, founder and constructor of the brand Ecolibri and General Manager of the company ACECABLING operational since 2005 in Chisinau, together with the Ambassador of the Italian Embassy in Chisinau Enrico Nunziato, was proceeded by a brief meeting at the Moldexpo Center, where Donatella Scarpa has presented to the public, the project Ecolibri in Moldova, born of a close collaboration with the Energy Agency "AEE" (<http://www.aee.md>) and Moldovan institutions.

*"In Italy, after the inauguration that took place last June in the presence of the General Director of the Chamber of Commerce of Monza and Brianza and of the President of the Province of Monza Brianza, given the very low environmental impact and given the particularities of the design, we were asked by the territorial authorities, to exhibit Ecolibri at the gardens of the Villa Reale in Monza, today the institutional site of MILAN EXPO 2015.*

*A year ago we presented our project Ecolibri to the Moldovan Energy Agency, which has found full support from its director Dr. Stratan." explains Donatella Scarpa and continues: "The decision to produce renewable standalone energy took shape in our internal, just to meet the needs for the energy demand in increase of all that countries which have a strong development and which don't have a capillary energy network .*

*It's aimed mainly to the demand for energy in agriculture, services for businesses and for public infrastructure, as well as support for airports and harbours, for tourist areas and the mountains and in all those situations where an autonomy for energy production is needed."*

Ecolibri is unique in its kind. The materials used for the sails as carbon and steel for the mechanical parts make it particularly suitable for all weather conditions also very harsh, as the strong winters in the Republic of Moldova, and the absolute innovation is that it produces energy in accumulation, with lithium batteries operated by inverter.

The installation of the first micro wind turbine Ecolibri in Chisinau took place after making a detailed study of the site and the wind conditions for a few months.

Donatella Scarpa reaffirms: *"Thanks to the continuous exchange of information and effective collaboration with the technicians of AEE, we first made an anemometer analysis to check the possibility to install Ecolibri on Moldavian ground. Subsequently the Agency gave the availability for installation at its site in via Grenoble. At this point the project becomes reality entering into an agreement of donation by ACECABLING of a complete micro wind turbine Ecolibri and by the AEE willingness to bear all the necessary infrastructure for the plant. "*

In February, a team of Italian technicians went to the place and made the installation, equipped with the latest electronic equipment to detect remotely all the features of the generator and to record the anemometric regulations.

*"This first step, we are sure, shared with Doctor. Startan, will bring in Moldova the opportunity to develop renewable energy in places now disadvantaged in terms of infrastructure and the transfer of high level technology with a direct consequence for the local employment, thanks to the fact that the electrical equipment will be produced directly in ACECABLING here in Chisinau for all plants that we will install. "* comments Donatella Scarpa at the end of her speech, thanking in particular the Italian-Moldavian Chamber of Commerce, which organized the meeting and all authorities.
